“KazTransOil” JSC increased the volume of oil exports from the Tengiz field in the direction of the Baku-Tbilisi-Ceyhan oil pipeline to 347.1 thousand tons in Q2 2023

In the II quarter of 2023, “KazTransOil” JSC in the port of Aktau shipped 347.1 thousand tons of oil from the Tengiz field for export in the direction of the Baku-Tbilisi-Ceyhan oil pipeline.

In the first quarter of 2023, in this direction, “KazTransOil” JSC shipped 19.2 thousand tons of oil from the Tengiz field for export.

In 2022, the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Kassym-Zhomart Tokayev, ordered to increase the transportation of oil along the Trans-Caspian corridor. In accordance with this instruction, JSC NC “KazMunayGas” and the state oil company of the Republic of Azerbaijan SOCAR signed an agreement providing for the transportation of 1.5 million tons of oil from the Tengiz field per year in the direction of the Baku-Tbilisi-Ceyhan oil pipeline.

“KazTransOil” JSC is the national operator of the main oil pipeline. It is part of the NC “KazMunayGas” JSC group. “KazTransOil” JSC owns a diversified network of main oil pipelines 5.4 thousand km in length.
